### Our Mission

Tapestri, Inc. is dedicated to ending violence and oppression in refugee and immigrant communities by using culturally competent and appropriate methods. As advocates for refugee and immigrant families affected by domestic violence, sexual assault, and exploitation, we are committed to using direct services, education, community organizing and advocacy to affect change in the lives of these families.

Between 2000 and 2006, Georgia experienced an average growth of 48.9% among its refugee and immigrant populations, compared to the national average of 20.7%. The majority of Georgia's immigrant and refugee populations are located in metropolitan Atlanta.

Tapestri collaborates with resettlement agencies, law enforcement agencies, and community-based organizations, which enables us to provide a coordinated response to survivors of violence from the immigrant and refugee communities.

We believe that every person has the right to live without fear. We exist to increase access to services for refugee and immigrant communities. We believe that everyone should be able to receive help and services that are respectful of her or his community, language, culture, race, age, sexual orientation, disability, and religious beliefs.



### Our Services

Providing direct services, including legal advocacy, to survivors of Human Trafficking and Domestic Violence.

Providing technical assistance and trainings on Domestic Violence, Human Trafficking, and Immigrant and Refugee Issues for all social service providers, law enforcement agencies, and interpreters.

Providing community outreach on Domestic Violence and Human Trafficking within Immigrant and Refugee communities through presentations and mass media.

Providing an ongoing 24-week Family Violence Intervention Program designed for refugee and immigrant men.
